

Plant list for garden at St Bartholomew the Great

The west churchyard of St Bartholomew's was replanted in September 2020. This was a joint project with the City Gardens team and the church. Paving was extended; handrails installed for the steps; a new yew hedge and benches have been added; the central grass area was removed and old shrubs dug out. Passers-by in Cloth Fair can now look through into the churchyard and the space is lighter and more inviting. The plants selected are good for pollinators. Biodiversity has also been enhanced with the installation of bird feeders, a bird bath, bird and bat boxes.
